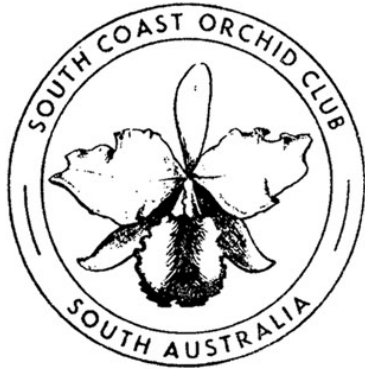

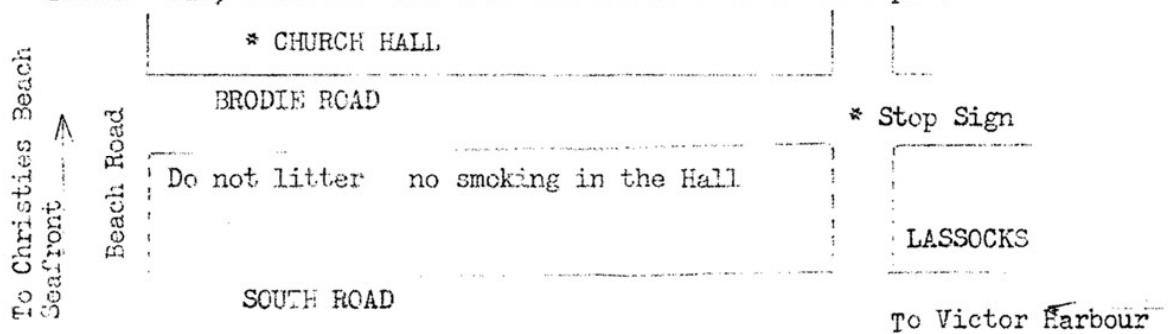

SEEDLING COMPETITION

The Club is to hold a seedling competition and plants will be available at the October meeting at a cost of \$3.50 each.

The crossing chosen has been selected by reason of the probability of a 50% pure colour. The Committee is currently preparing guidelines for the competition and it is envisaged that plants will be judged throughout the growth and that prizes will be awarded in two sections namely pure colour and otherwise. Blooms will be required to be of a standard to be determined.

The Crossing chosen is SUSSEX DAWN 'DOROTHY MAY' x PHAROH 'WINTER MIST' probable greens and whited. Plants will be 12" potted in 5 pint pots in humus.
