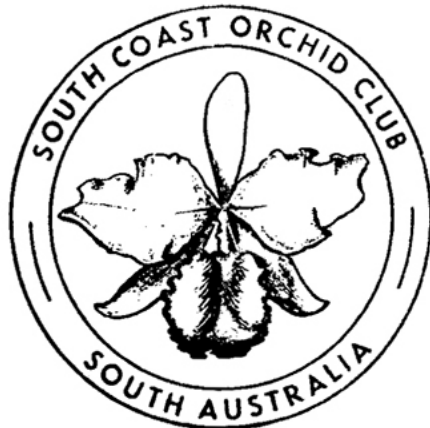

Material to bring:--

1. Tall container (If you wish a tall bottle will do)
2. Pinpoint or oasis.
3. Curved material or material that can be manipulated
e.g. Broom or pussy willow
4. Flowers in gradation from bud to full bloom.
Buds or small flowers needed on extremities and one focal flower.
Design follows S line
5. Notebook and pencil.

Memo:-- Preliminary notice is given that the topic for the November meeting will be 'Diagonal Line' Required material will be foliage such as privot or similar not too big in leaf--about 9 pieces in all.
Additional 5-7 flowers.
