HELPFUL HINTS

Cymbidiums which have finished flowering (or wont be flowering) should be repotted or divided so they can become established by the time the new growth is ready to start. The earlier this task gets completed the surer the plants will become established and growing again. Now is the time to commence watering the dendrobiums etc that have been on a restricted watering over the winter and also cast an eye over your cattleyas. If the new growths have started and are sending down roots then it is time to repot and divide.
