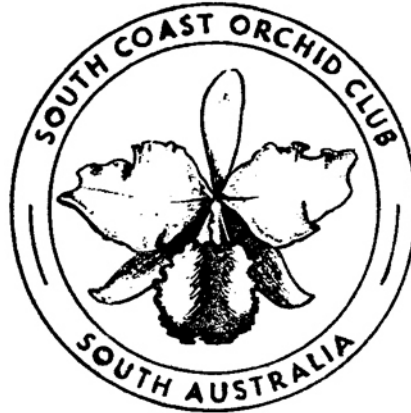

At the June Meeting of the Club an expression of depth of Interest was ascertained to the activity of Floral Art and in particular to the holding of a Meeting on the first TUESDAY of each Month specifically arranged for the purpose.

It is clearly evident that a number in excess of 30 Members are interested as a Club activity and your Committee had no hesitation in arranging that the first meeting will be held: -

TUESDAY, 2 AUGUST AT 7.45 P.M.

In the

LUTHERAN CHURCH HALL - KINDERGARTEN AREA.

For the purposes of instruction in basic lines, principles and ground work any material available to Members consistent with the needs of the Instructor will be used. In Club competition, only Orchids will be used. Membership of the Floral Art Group will be by membership of the South Coast Orchid Club. Members attending will be "Bringing and Doing". The first topic will be "Vertical Design" and it will be necessary for Members to bring the following material:-

1. Tall or flat container - does not need to be ornate.
2. Needle aid or Pin Point.
3. Plasticine
4. 5 or 6 strap leaves such as Iris or Watsonia leaves.
5. 3 or 4 flowers - from bud to open flower - for gradation.
6. Secateurs.
7. Notebook and pencil.

SPECIAL NOTE: Flowers should be picked either the night before or early morning and placed in water.

N.B. The wearing of Club name badges will greatly assist the instructor in establishing a relationship with the Members.
