Cymbidium growers these are a few reminders for the month of September

1. Give as much light as possible
2. Be careful not to spray plants in spike as there is a possible danger of malformation to the buds if you do.
3. Begin your high nitrogen fertiliser in the form of foliar fertilising to the plants that have flowered
4. Start the dividing of your mature plants and check your seedlings for potting on.

This is a hint from a well known judge and exhibitor that may help you to prepare your plants for showing either at the monthly meeting or show:-

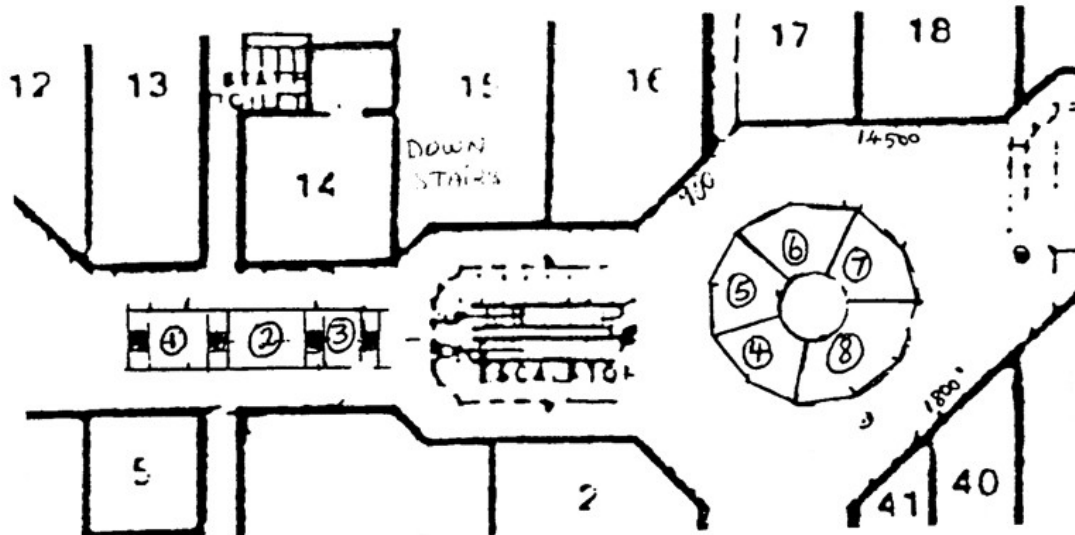
"Mix a little milk with water and wipe down your foliage using a cloth dipped in the solution. This gives the plant a more natural appearance than if you should use a weak white oil solution or the commercial 'leafshine'. Also it is much safer for should you use a white oil solution that is too strong there is a possibility that you may defoliate your plant."

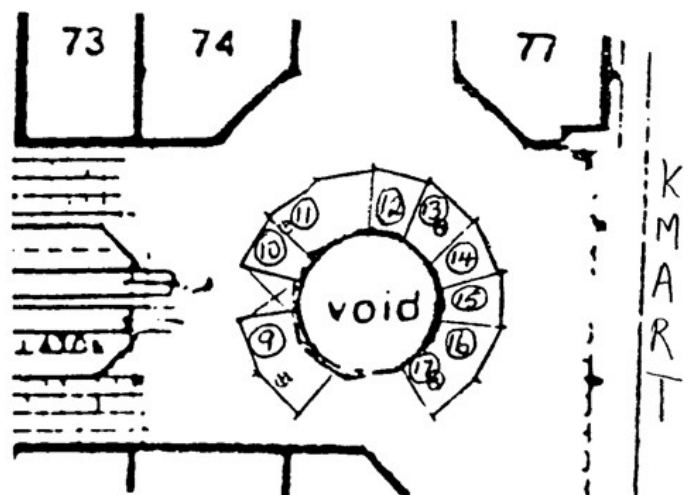
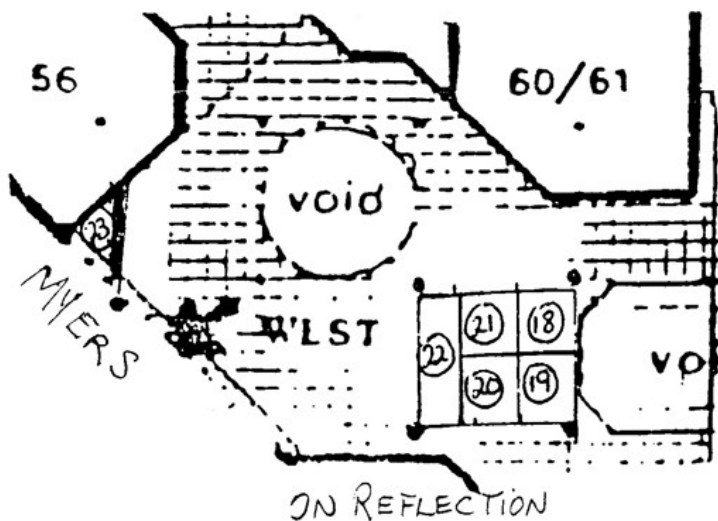


THE SOUTH COAST ORCHID CLUB SPRING SHOW 1985

FROM THE JUDGES' TABLE: -

Did you have a good look at the Intermediate Cymbidium Little Bighorn 'Papoose'? The plant shown by John Jansma is another very fine seedling from the already successful crossing Dag x Sussex Moor registered by Featherhill Exotics in 1982. The crossing has already gained an Award of Breeder's Merit from the Cymbidium Society of America Inc.

This crossing has produced both 'pure color' and clones that carry the red factor, this comes from the pollen parent Sussex Moor which carries the pure color factor. Of the two types those clones which carry the pure color I believe have received more recognition from the judges as more of these have received awards, in fact another seedling that John has grown on from the flask that he obtained has just been awarded by the judges from the O.C.ofS.A. but this still has to be ratified.

So keep the name "Little Bighorn" for a future addition to your shadehouse

It's a pity that nurseries continue to sell their seedlings to the Public in the crossing name even after they have been registered, but our members should endeavour to keep their own records up-to-date as the local nurseries I believe do do the right thing by producing lists of their recent registrations and these lists are put out for you to pick up on your visit, also in the Club library we have a monthly publication 'The Orchid Review' published in England and each month in the centre spread publish the latest registrations.

At our August meeting there were at least three cymbidiums benched still with the seedling cross on the label

1. Lunagrad x Zumma Boyd = Valley Bay
2. Sylvania x Keera = Lisa Rose
3. Sarah Jean X Wyanga = Mini Mint

all three I believe worthy of being correctly named.

This also applies to other genera, there are two Zygotetrum crossings that we often see on our benches most of which are also worthy of being correctly named:-

1. Blackyii x crinitum = John Banks
2. mackyii x Blackyii = B.G.White
