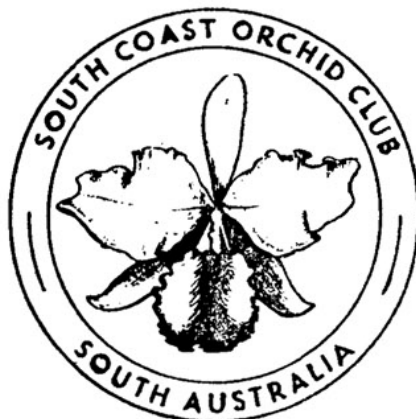

## WINTER AND SPRING SHOWS

### - EXHIBITORS RULES -

1. All exhibitors must be financial members of the South Coast Orchid Club of S.A. Inc.
2. Entries are free.
3. Exhibitors are bound by the Constitution, Rules, By-laws and Special Show Rules of the South Coast Orchid Club of S.A. Inc.
4. The opinion of the Judges is final and binding and no objections or discussions regarding results will be considered with the one exception of an infringement by an exhibitor of any of the Club's Laws, By-Laws, or Show Rules. Any objection in this case must be lodged in writing with the Club Secretary.
5. All exhibits must be arranged by 7.45 p.m. (Winter Show)
6. The Club reserves the right to photograph any of the exhibits.
7. The Club accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or infection suffered by any plant or bloom exhibited.
8. All matters regarding the arrangement and conducting of the Show, with the exception of judging the Show Marshall is the ruling authority.
9. No plants suspected by the Club Virus Adjudicators of being infected with virus, will be eligible for competition and such plants will be completely isolated from all other plants.
10. Exhibits must not be removed before 10.15 p.m. (Winter Show)
11. The exhibition area will be closed from 8 p.m. to 9 p.m. (Winter Show) to allow judging to take place. No exhibitors, public or members other than the Show Marshall, Judges of the Club and Associate Judges will be allowed to remain in the exhibition area during this period.
12. Non exhibitors are requested not to congregate in the exhibition area prior to 8 p.m. (Winter Show) so that Officials can arrange plants and perform necessary duties unhindered.
