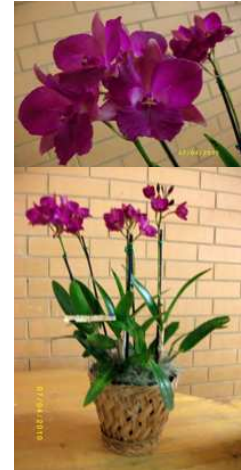
April Results (cont.)

Plant Commentary, April 2010 Meeting.

Flower of Second Division and Flower of the Night: *Cym. dayanum* grown by George Misirlis. A large specimen plant with 20+ inflorescences with most or all flowers open and a number of spikes still in bud with inflorescences cascading down around the pot. Flowers were 30 – 40mm wide and 40mm tall. Sepals and petals were cream with a maroon stripe along the midline and the labellum was red around the edge with a yellow centre.



Flower of First Division: *Ctna. Hunabu Fairy Flare 'Joyleen'* benched by Rito and Rosetta Silvestri. The plant displayed five inflorescences, three with all flowers (6, 5 and 5) open and the other two with 3 flowers fully open and two and four buds still to open. Sepals and petals were mainly of a similar shade of deep purple changing to pink/cream at their base and the labellum shaded to deeper purple towards the base.



Flower of Open Division: *Onc. trulliferum* grown by Richard and Beryl Wilson. A well grown example of this species bearing two much branched inflorescences carrying some 78 and 54 flowers. The yellow sepals were small, the petals yellow with some light brown barring, both being complimented by the showy yellow labellum. The particular interest in this plant was that originally the label had been lost and some years ago Richard had been told that it was the species *Onc. ampliatum* even though he felt it was not correct. The judges on the night were able to correct the name after checking with books and Orchid Wiz.

Grand Champion and Champion Open Division:

Sten. longifolia grown by Geoff and Lucy Spear. A large bowl of this species, well grown with some 24 inflorescences of the small light pink/purple flowers which open progressively. A good display of open flowers on each stem, the small 8mm wide by 15mm tall flowers had pink sepals and petals with deeper small spotting and a very attractive pink 5 mid-lobed labellum complimented the fine dainty flower.



Champion First Division: *Lc. Ondine* grown by Dorothy Carassai. A well displayed plant with two inflorescences of three and four flowers. Flowers were 90mm wide by 100mm tall. Sepals and petals were a sparkling mid-pink complimented with lighter pink labellum with sidelobes curving up over the column and yellow towards its base inside.



Champion Second Division and Champion Oncidiinae *Onc. Odontioda Samurai* grown by Grace Noll. A well grown plant with three spikes of 9, 9 and 10 open flowers and one spike still in bud. The sepals and petals of the flowers were deep maroon with 1 to 2mm of green at their tips. The labellum had a large white mid-lobe of white resembling the skirt of a 'dancing lady' with maroon shading towards the base.

Plant Commentary, May 2010 Meeting.

Flower of First Division and Flower of the Night: *Den. monophyllum* benched by David and Kay Camac. A well grown example of this Australian native mounted on a piece cork. the species is found down the Q'land coast into Northern NSW in nature. The plant had a single inflorescence of 17 small open flowers approx. 7mm across and tall with pale greenish yellow sepals and petals with a contrasting deeper yellow labellum.



Flower of Second Division: *Onc. Sweet Sugar* grown by Paul and Donja Hayes. The plant displayed five branched inflorescences with 30 to 35 mm wide and 45 to 50mm flowers. Sepals and petals were greenish yellow with light brown cross striping complimented by a large yellow labellum with a light brown patch at the base and a deeper yellow column.



Flower of Open Division: *Zel. onusta* grown by Noel Oliver. A well grown example of this species bearing two unbranched inflorescences of 12 and 15 flowers nicely arranged along the stems. Flowers were approximately 25mm wide and 30mm long. The petals and labellum were an even strong yellow with deep orange fine striping at their bases giving the flowers a highlight and the small sepals were yellow with a slight green hue.
