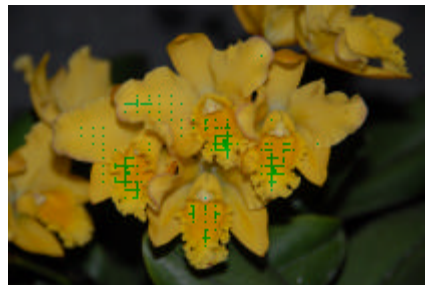

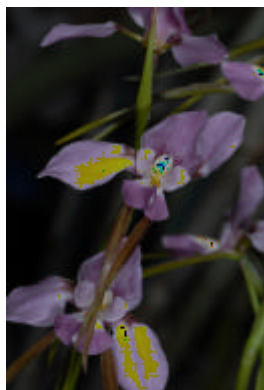

SPECIES GROUP

Once again we were amazed at the beautiful species orchids presented at our October 'Species Group'. More than 30 plants were benched originating from many different countries. One of the most beautiful plants presented and really caught my eye was *Den. densiflorum*. This plant had several 200 mm pendulous racemes of 25 mm flowers of bright yellow with a stunning deep yellow/orange velvety labellum. This is an Indian epiphyte species growing in mountainous forests. It requires a well drained mixture, part shade, intermediate conditions, plenty of water during summer with a watering rest period during winter. This plant was brought in by Russell and Edda.

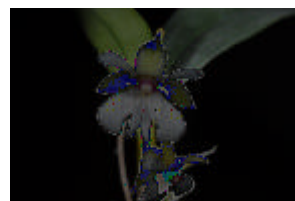


Den. densiflorum

Neil Shirley always treats us with something unusual at these meetings. This time he presented *Den. aberrans* which was only a very small plant but carried two exquisite flat white/cream flowers that had one of the most unusual labellums. This is a New Guinea species and grows in colonies as an epiphyte on trees in forest areas.

Neil also presented *Sarcochilus spathulatus*. This was a very small plant growing on a thin stick – something like you would throw and ask your dog to fetch – the amazing flowers were quite small but very stunning. They were not like the shape of the normal *Sarcochilus* usually seen but were more longer with cream/white petals and sepals with an iridescent greenish labellum.

Sarcochilus Resptrepia Disa Australian Cymbidium Masdevallia Dockrillia Diuris Dendrobium Cattleya Laelia Paphiopedilum Oncidium Scaphyglottis Epidendrum

David Harmer presented a PowerPoint Presentation on the different Sections of the *Paphiopedilum* genus, showing us many beautiful species some we were familiar with but others that have only recently been discovered.

The meeting concluded about 9.30 pm after which a 'cuppa' and a chat was enjoyed. Pat Harmer

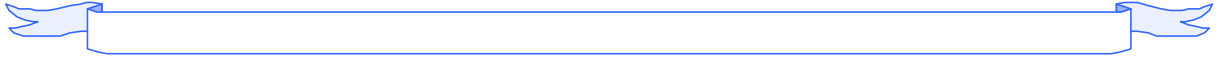
