## A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PRESIDENT

I report as follows:

### Species Group

16 Enthusiasts met at South Brighton where interesting and unusual plants were discussed. The Seedling Cym. ebernun was tabled and Peter Galpin's plant was selected as best culture after one year from plants obtained, his plant was far superior to all the others benched, he told me he only uses Miracle Gro as his fertiliser for all orchids which suggests species Cymbidium like it as well.

### Daytime Group

16 members joined in for an interesting meeting. Guest Speaker, Trevor Jacobs, told us the story of development of Judging of Orchids. He also conveyed his method of staking an orchid from slightly pendulous to straight up and the correct tying procedure in respect to tying an orchid for the Show Bench. He also asked those present to point up a plant displayed of White Valley Becky for award judging, an area where most of those present had never ventured before – most of us present were too generous in our assessment. Thank you Trevor and Margaret.

### Winter Show

You, the members, provided an excellent display for the Public to view and a most successful trading table. Thank you to your Committee and those members who assisted by showing plants and working for your Club. The final figure earned for Club funds was \$1225.

### Monthly Meeting

This meeting was in two parts – firstly, a Special General Meeting as advertised. The result was that the advertised motion was defeated and an amendment passed, details of the final amendment as accepted are elsewhere in the Bulletin as an attachment to your copy of the Constitution.

OFFICERS

10. (a) The Officers of the Club shall be a President, two Vice Presidents (one of whom shall be elected Senior Vice President by the Committee, Honorary Secretary and an Honorary Treasurer, all of whom shall hold office until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting, when they shall retire. ***The retiring President shall not be eligible for reelection if he has held that office for the previous three years , except in the situation where no other nomination for the position has been received*** but otherwise all other retiring officers shall be eligible for re-election from year to year.
