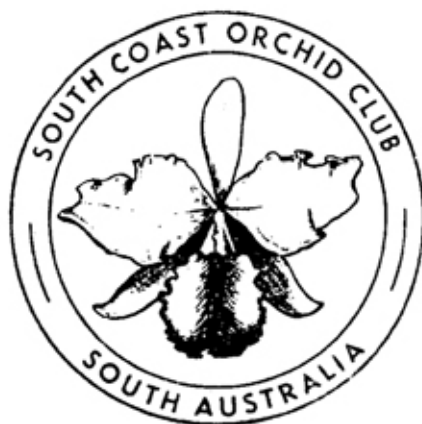

1. Flat container --does not need to,be ornate.
2. Needle and or pin point
3. Plasticine
4. Secateurs
- 5.* Naturally curved foliage or foliage which can be manipulated to part of circle.
- 6.* Flowers -- in line design -- small buds to focal flower.
7. Notebook and pencil

* Material selected should relate to the container and likewise should be objectively chosen having due regard to the topic.
