Cym. Minuet and Cym. Peter Pan and its progeny, are usually the first cymbidiums seen on the benches at this time of the year.

Cym. Minuet is the result of a crossing of two species, Cym insigne and Cym. pumilum. Cym insigne an Asian (Vietnam) species bears erect spikes, 3'-4' high with 14 or moore 4" flowers. The flowers are whitish suffused with rose-lilac, the bases of the sepals and petals thickly dotted with crimson red, the lip rounded yellowish on the disc the whole beautifully flusfed, lined and dotted crimson purple on a white ground.

Cym. pumilum is a dwarf growing species from Japan. It has narrow leaves and the 6" spikes are erect with small flowers. Sepals and petals are light red-brown, lip whitish dotted with red-brown with a yellow disc. Cym. Minuet has taken after Cym. pumilum in its flowering pattern in late summer, Cym. insigne flowers in spring, the flowers are usually smallish, pale-pink suffused yellow with redish-brown spotting on the lips. The plant grows quickly into large specimens and flowers freely each year with tall erect spikes, carrying anything up to 16 flowers.

Cym. Peter Pan is much more complex in its breeding. One of its parents is a species Cym. ensifolium but its other parent Cym. Miretta is the result of much interbreeding of hybrids and 7 species, some of which have been used several times.

Cym. Peter Pan has inherited the best characteristics of both parents. Autumn flowering and a beautiful fragerance from Cym. ensifolium whilst the colour and the quality of the 3"flowers comes from Cym. Miretta. The colour of the petals and sepals is pale green, the lip is heavily shaded and edged with deep red. The quality of the flower has been further enhanced by 'colochine treatment' making a 4N thus giving larger flowers with more intense colouration.

Congratulations to one of our younger growers, John Hilhorst, for his plant of Cym. Minuet, which was judged as best on the 2nd Division bench at the March Cultural Meeting

EXHIBITORS' RULES - WINTER SHOW

- 1. All exhibitors must be financial members of the South Coast Orchid Club of South Austrália Incorporated.
- 2. Entries are free.
- 3. Exhibitors are bound by the Constitution, Rules and By-Laws and Special Show Rules of the Club.
- 4. The opinion of the Judges is final and binding and no objections or discussion regarding results will be considered with one exception of an infrigement by an exhibitor of any of the Club's Laws, By-Laws, or Show Rules. Any objection in this case must be lodged with the Club Show Marshall.
- 5. The Club accepts no responsibilty for any loss, damage or infection suffered by any plant or blooms exhibited.
- 6. The Club reserves the right to photograph any of the exhibit if it should so wish.
- 7. In all matters regarding the arrangement and conducting of the Show, with the exception of matters pertaining to the judging, the Show Marshall is the ruling authority.
- 8. No plant suspected by the Club's 'Virus Adjudicators' of being infected with virus will be eligible for competition and such plant(s) will be completely isolated from all other plants.
- 9. The exhibition area will be closed during judging. No exhibitors, public or member other than the Show Marshall, Registrar of Judges, Judges and Associate Judges of the Club and other person so appointed as to assist with the judging will be allowed to remain in the exhibition area during this period.
- 10. Non-exhibitors are requested not to congregate in the exhibition area prior to judging so that Officials can arrange plants and perform other necessary duties unhindered.
- 11. Plants must be labelled with the colored labels provided by the Club with exhibitor's number and name of plant. Supply of these labels can be obtained from the Show Marshall or his nominee.
- 12. Exhibitors are to ensure that that all labelling be neatly and correctly performed in accordance with the procedure laid down on Orchid Nomeclature and Registration. Labelling shall be legible from a reasonable distance.
- 13. All exhibits must be benched between 6.00pm and 3.30pm.
- 14. Exhibits must be removed and the Hall cleaned by 5.30pm.
- 15. Exhibitors unable to remove their own plants from the Show should provide the person doing so with a letter of authorisation.
- 16. Damage caused in transit to the Show should be reported to the Show Marshall or Registrar of Judges prior to the commencement of judging.
- 17. If in the opinion of the Judge, a plant not being worthy of an award or prize in any specified section, then none shall be given.
