February Plant Commentary

Second Division and Plant of the Night: *Onc.* Sharry Baby 'Mutation' benched by Paul and Donja Hayes. A very well grown and presented plant bearing four arching inflorescences with most of the flowers open and two more inflorescences still in bud. The flowers were well presented and even on the stems, the outer quarter to one third of the sepals and petals being very pale green then deep maroon towards the base. The labellum displayed a large white 'skirt' and was maroon near the centre.



February Plant Commentary (cont)

Open Division: *C. loddigesii* benched by Richard and Beryl Wilson. A very attractive plant displaying nine flowers 85 mm wide x 75 mm tall. The sepals and petals were deep purple-pink. The labellum was large and showy and was creamish-white, the mid lobe being frilled around the edge with shading of pink/purple making a very showy display of flowers.



First Division: *C. schilleriana* shown by Rod and Judy McRedmond. A relatively small, but worthy, plant of two canes each bearing a single flower 130 mm across x 130 mm tall. The narrow sepals and the slightly broader petals with very lightly ruffled edges were pristine white. The central outer lobe of the labellum was also lightly frilled at the end and was purple making a very attractive contrast with the rest of the segments. The rest of the labellum was also white.



It was great to see two species winners of the night.
