The Committee of the Orchid Club of South Australia invites members to attend the meeting of the Club on Thursday, August 6th at 8-00pm at the Australian Mineral Foundation. The guest speaker will be the internationally renowned Botanist Professor Arditti talk will be 'The History of Orchid Propagation,' and will include seed germination and tissue culture. The talk will be at a popular level, and not too technical and boring, slides will be shown.

As a follow up to the Club Meeting a seminar will be staged on Sunday 9th. August 1981, also at the Australian Mineral Foundation. On this day Prof. Arditti, will speak on the factors affecting the flowering of orchids, and go into some detail on 'Tissue Culture,' in the 2nd. session. The two sessions will be divided by afternoon tea. Members of all Affiliated Societies are cordially invited to attend either, or both, of the presentations, by Professor Arditti.
