November Plant Commentary

Flower of Second Division: *Lyc. Lucianii* benched by Trevor Stuttley. The plant had four inflorescences with a single flower, three were fully open and the other still in bud. Flowers were 95mm across and 90mm tall. Sepals were pale green with a pink blush, petals cream with pale pink on the reverse and the labellum cream with deep pink markings. This primary hybrid between *Lyc. lasioglossa* and *Lyc. skinneri* was registered in 1972



Flower of First Division: *Cym. Cricket* 'Rosetta' benched by Rito and Rosetta Silvestri. This plant had 14 spikes cascading down over the pot, and were up to double the length of the pot, nine of which had at least 2/3rds of their flowers open. Flowers just over 25mm to 30mm wide and approximately 38mm tall, sepals and petals brown with very fine red spotting over the surface, petals being somewhat redder and darker. Labellum deep maroon all over and the column pollen cap was cream.



Flower of Open Division and Flower of the Night: *Sarco. Heidi* grown by Kevin Trevan. A very well grown plant with 15 inflorescences with many open flowers, some buds still to open in some cases and one inflorescence still in bud. Flowers were 20 – 22mm wide x about 28mm tall, well shaped and filled in. Sepals and petals were white with a few fine pink spots on the outer 2/3rds of the petals and sepals with much heavier markings on the inner third. The typically small labellum was pale yellow.

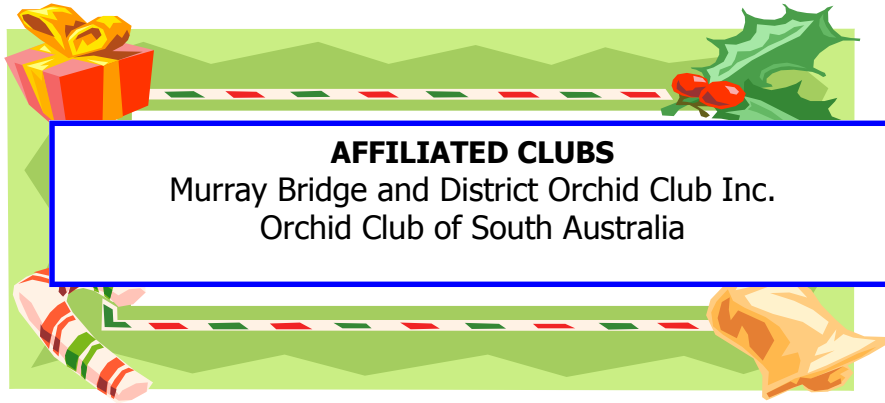
