On the Bench at the June Meeting

Flower of Open Division and Flower of the Night:

Onc. pulvinatum benched by Noel Oliver. A large well-grown plant with six long pendulous and branching inflorescences arranged around the pot. The inflorescences carried numerous flowers 22mm across by 28mm tall. The flowers had yellow sepals and petals that were light brown towards their base. The small long and narrow yellow labellum was spotted with brown and had flat side-lobes and a divided mid-lobe.



A few other plants on the bench:

Doritis pulcherima benched by Gerald Voskamp, a species found in China, Burma south to Malaya and north Sumatra. Gerald grows this plant in a medium of fine cork in a shade house with a canopy to protect plant from winter rain. The plant was very well grown with six upright inflorescences with well displayed deep purple pink flowers with white markings towards the base of the labellum. The flowers were approximately 23mm wide and 25mm tall.

Onc. Sweet Sugar 'Su-Mi' grown by Suzanne Saunders. This plant carried three tall branched inflorescences of flowers 48mm wide by 45mm. The yellow sepals and petals were barred brown and the large showy yellow labellum had a solid brown patch at its base.



Paph. Glaucopar, a primary hybrid between *Paph. parishii* and *Paph glaucophyllum*, benched by Heather Engelhardt. A medium sized plant of four growths, the lead producing a single inflorescence with two open flowers and a bud. The pale green dorsal sepal was striped green and light brown, the ventral sepal green striping on a pale green base. The medium length twisted petals (influenced by both parents) had a light green base with maroon spotting and short hairs. The pouch was finely spotted light brown on light green base.

Den. (lithacola x Fullmoon). A small plant of four canes, two of which carried inflorescences, benched by Brian & Moyna Leedham. The smaller cane had an inflorescence with three open flowers and a bud, the other one had two inflorescences with five and four open flowers. The deep purple flowers were well filled in and had slightly darker labellums. They were 48mm wide and 43mm tall.



Onc. Sharry Baby 'Sweet Fragrance' grown by Des and Hazel Alsop. A well grown plant with a single upright branched inflorescence carrying numerous 30mm x 38mm flowers. The sepals and petals were deep maroon, some with small light cream patches and the labellums were a slightly lighter shade of maroon on a creamish-white base and were striped towards the base.
