September Plant Commentary

Flower of Open Division and Flower of the Night: *Colm. Jungle Monarch* 'Daphne' benched by Gerald Voskamp. A well grown plant in a medium sized pot bearing four upright inflorescences bearing 11, 9, 8 and 6 open flowers, with the smaller two having 2 buds each still to open. Flowers were 40mm wide and 45mm tall, the petals being light green heavily overlaid with deep reddish-brown barring. The labellums were white with lighter reddish-brown markings near the centre.



Flower of First Division: *Dock. teretifolia* grown by David and Kay Camac. A very well grown and displayed plant with numerous inflorescences carrying from four to seven flowers. The flower sepals and petals were white as was labellum, the mid lobe curling down and under was finely spotted with pink.



Flower of Second Division: *Cym. Bedivere* 'Highbury' grown by George Misirlis. This strongly growing plant bore eight pendulous spikes in pairs around the pot carrying between 46 and 26 flowers with a few still to open. The flowers were 50mm to 55mm across by 50mm tall. Sepals and petals were light brown on a pale green base with a white labellum with pink shading on the mid-lobe.



September Plant Commentary (cont.)

A couple of other plants benched by members:

***Paph. Memoria Larry Hever* grown by Trevor Stutley.** The flower had pale green sepals, the petals also pale green overlaid with fine maroon spotting giving them a darker shade to contrast with the sepals. The pouch was greenish-cream with maroon spotting on the inside surface which did show through lightly to the outer surface.

Cym. (Dorothea Page x Yowie Flame) benched Geoff and Lucy Spear. A small plant with a single upright inflorescence of seven colourful well shaped flowers 105mm wide x 100mm tall. Deep maroon sepals and petals with even fine venation along their length and a very narrow cream edge. The cream labellum was widely barred with deep red on the mid-lobe with some deep red spotting on the side lobes.

Information about Mt. Beenak Orchids (by Clive & Agi Halls)

Clive Halls is guest speaker for the October main meeting and has kindly supplied to us a history of his Nursery.

"We have been trading now as Mt. Beenak Orchids for 31 years, so we are probably one of Aussies oldest Orchid Nurseries currently running. I began my career back in 1963 at Sanders Orchids as an apprentice. Later I worked in the Dutch cut flower business before emigrating to Australia in 1973 I had by chance found out McBeans Orchids Australia needed a grower so I was in the orchid game again & stayed there for a very excellent 7 years getting a footing in the country & so forth. Agi also worked there in the laboratory for sometime before resuming nursing. In the last couple of years there I began to import flasks from Keith Andrew in the UK for the nucleus of our own nursery. When we moved out to Three Bridges I worked part time at McBeans for a short time but the travelling was too much so I left & we went out on our own. I worked for a while with a local fencing contractor but soon the demands for the pendulous type cymbs we were bringing in grew big enough for a full time operation. By this time I had the agency for Geyserland Orchids & we began a long & profitable association with Andy Easton.

Later we branched out into various other genera, first Odontoglossums then Masdevallias Sarcocylus, & Zygopetalums. We breed most of the stock we sell in these genera & Agi does all the laboratory work so we are very self sufficient. Our Odont. alliance mericlones are all imported from Floricultura in the Netherland, the leading producer of these type of Orchid in the world. We now have the agency for Neville Roper Sarcocylus. As for the future who knows, more flasks & less plant production probably, as our overseas market increases None of our children seem interested in the nursery so in due course Mt. Beenak Orchids like many before it will become just a name in the Orchid history books. Hopefully some of our hybrids will stand the test of time & the Mt. Beenak name will be remembered for some of its contribution to new hybrids."
