EXHIBITORS' RULES FOR SHOWS

1. All exhibitors must be financial members of the South Coast Orchid Club of South Australia Incorporated.
2. Entries are free.
3. Exhibitors are bound by the constitution, Rules, By-Laws and Special Show Rules of the Club.
4. The opinion of the judges is final and binding and no objections or discussions regarding results will be considered, with one exception, which is an infringement by an Exhibitor of any of the Club's Rules, By-Laws or Show Rules. Any objection in this case must be lodged with the Club Show Marshall/Secretary.
5. The Club accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or infection suffered by any plant or blooms exhibited.
6. The Club reserves the right to photograph any of the exhibits if it should so wish.
7. In all matters regarding the arrangement and conduct of the show (with the exception of judging) the Show Marshall/Secretary is the ruling Authority.
8. No plants suspected by the Club Virus adjudicators of being infected with virus will be eligible for competition and such plants will be completely isolated from all other plants.
9. The exhibition areas will be closed during the judging. No exhibitors, the public or members other than the Show Marshall/Secretary, Judges of the Club, Associate Judges and other persons appointed to assist in judging will be allowed to remain in the exhibition area during this period.
10. Non-exhibitors are requested not to congregate in the exhibition area prior to judging so that officials can arrange plants and perform other necessary duties unhindered.
11. Plants must be labelled with the coloured labels provided by the Club with the exhibitor's number and name of plant. These are available from the Show Marshall/Secretary or his/her nominee.
12. Exhibitors are to ensure that all labelling be neatly and correctly performed in accordance with the procedure laid down on orchid Nomenclature and Registration.
13. All plants benched for judging at the show must be made available to be in the club display for the show week.
14. All exhibits must be benched by the nominated time on the nominated day for judging. The nominated day and time will be published in the Club gazette in the month prior to the Show.
15. Exhibits must not be removed before nominated time on the nominated day at the end of the Display week. The nominated day and time will be published in the Club gazette in the month prior to the Show.
16. Exhibitors unable to remove their own plants from the show should provide the person so doing with a letter of authorization.
17. Damage caused in transit to the show should be reported to the Show Marshall/secretary or Registrar of Judges prior to judging.
18. If, in the opinion of the judges, a plant is not worthy of an award or prize in any specified section, then none shall be given.

July Plant Commentary

Flower of Second Division and Flower of the Night:

Cym. Gypsy Rose 'Dana' benched by Michael Willoughby and Oui Ju. A well grown plant with four well displayed inflorescences bearing 18 to 22 flowers 45 to 50 mm tall x 50 to 55 mm wide. The flowers were arranged evenly all around the stem. Petals and sepals were deep pink edged cream. The mid-lobe of the labellum was very deep crimson and cream towards the centre and the column was a deeper cream with a pale yellow cap.



July Plant Commentary (cont.)

Flower of Open Division:

C. maxima benched by Richard and Beryl Wilson. This was a strongly growing plant with two lead canes each with 5 flowers, one a little more open than the other. The flowers were 130 mm tall x 140 mm wide. The sepals and petals were mid purple and the mid-lobe of the labellum was lavender pink overlaid by deep purple venation (veining) and pink to white around the frilled edge.



Flower of First Division:

Onc. Sharry Baby 'Sweet Fragrance' benched by Rod and Judy McRedmond. This was a large well grown plant with a large inflorescence of fully open flowers on thirteen side branches and 67 flowers. The sepals and petals were deep maroon, the mid-lobe of the labellum was white on the 'skirt' near the edge shading to a deep reddish colour near the flower centre and the side lobes were lighter maroon.
