DAYTIME CHAPTER by R. & W. Clark

28 members were welcomed by Keith for the final meeting of 1992, and seasonal greetings were relayed by some unable to attend. It was noted that the Christmas Luncheon had been an enjoyable outing and thanks were extended to Helen Edwards for the table decorations that enhanced the occasion.

Keith then discussed different types of potting mix, i.e. any material put together for growing plants. Orchid mixes are readily available commercially and come in different grades :- fine, medium, coarse and very coarse. The medium chosen for orchids is pine bark - the coarser the chunks the more air in the mix and the smaller the

smaller the surface for holding water. Different orchids require different mixes, e.g.

5mm-8mm used for seedlings

8mm-18mm used for most Cattleyas as they are more epiphytic.

Keith's preferred mix for cymbidiums is-

2 buckets (9-10lt) Pinebark

2 generous handfuls of Azalea/Camellia food

1 or 2 handfuls of shellgrit or marble chips (1/4" - 1/8")

Both the shellgrit and the marble chips are very slow solubles and a helpful additive for keeping roots healthier.

Debco is Keith's preferred bark for cattleyas and phalaenopsis.

Lesley Gunn, on her first visit to the Afternoon Meeting, was invited to make her choice from the variety of orchids on display and chose Enc. Bees Knees grown by C. & H. Edwards. This was also the popular choice, followed by Lc. Mary Elizabeth Bohn and (L. cinnabarina X C. luteola) X L. cowanii both grown by Keith Northcote.

A fun time followed with the annual raffle of 'pick-a-prize'.

Keith then announced that though this was to be his last meeting as Convenor he intends to be around and will be available to share his expertise on growing orchids. Harry Viney expressed the appreciation of the meeting to Keith which was followed by a hearty round of applause.

A very festive afternoon tea and chat rounded off the meeting.


